

## Jersey Tide streams and currents at Icho and Seymour towers.


These diagrams were produced by the Jersey Spear fishing club. Sadly the site does not seem to list them any more.

This gives you an idea of how the tides flow in the Ramsar south east coast wetlands site. Streams can be like a river in the gullies at half tide. A great Bass fishing area. But take care on the fast rising tide. It really will rise at 3inches per minute on a Spring tide of 12m.

On the flood tide the East stream starts about 1 hour before low.
